“Why not combine FOOTBALL WITH YOUR STUDIES at Hackney Community College”

Last year a brand new Football Academy was launched at Hackney Community College, which runs in association with the Academy of Sport East London. The U18's side play in the Ryman Youth League for the semi-professional club Tilbury.

A number of our youth players also play regularly for the men's Reserve team, and have even made First team appearances in front of over 400 attendees. The Football Academy has so far had an outstanding debut season in the league, whilst reaching the FA Youth Cup - Third Qualifying Round.

Our Academy coaches Jason Fevrier and Lee Hayes have been involved in the football industry for a number of years. They both have extensive football experience and knowledge. Having coached at one of Tottenham Hotspur's development centres, they have had a number of players on trial and signed for various academies.

Throughout this college scheme players will have the opportunity to be scouted and trial at professional/semi-professional football clubs. In joining the academy players will also gain Certificates FA level 1 and 2 in coaching football.



Requirements: To be part of the academy program students will need to attend a full time course of their choice at the college. Students will have to have played a reasonable level of football at school and/or with a club, and be prepared to train and work very hard. Training takes place on Monday evenings 6:00-8:00 and Saturday mornings 9:30-11:30, with League games Wednesday evenings from 6:30.
